

DASSAULT SYSTEMES OFFERING SPECIFIC TERMS (OST) FOR 3DEXPERIENCE R2026x ONLINE SERVICES ADDITIONAL TERMS #1

These additional terms #1, which supplement the Offering Specific Terms for 3DEXPERIENCE R2026x Online Services, are an integral part of such Offering Specific Terms. Except as expressly supplemented by these additional terms #1, all terms and conditions of the Offering Specific Terms for 3DEXPERIENCE R2026x Online Services shall remain in full force and effect.

The Offering Specific Terms for 3DEXPERIENCE R2026x Online Services together with these additional terms #1 (OST) and the terms incorporated herein by reference (including terms referenced on a website) are an integral part of the license and online services agreement between 3DS and Customer ("Agreement"), which refers to this OST. In the event of a discrepancy, inconsistency or contradiction between this OST and the other terms of the Agreement, the provisions of this OST shall prevail, but only with respect to the Online Services to which this OST applies. Customer acknowledges that it has full knowledge of all the terms of this OST and those incorporated herein by reference.

2. LICENSING SCHEMES AND GEOGRAPHIC SCOPE

2.2 SPECIFIC PROVISIONS FOR CERTAIN 3DS OFFERINGS

3DEXPERIENCE Open business category

Platform specialization

The following provisions supersede those of the corresponding section of the Offering Specific Terms for 3DEXPERIENCE R2026x Online Services:

A given Platform can be specialized by means of set of specialization features ("Specialization Set"). Unless otherwise specified in the Documentation, one (1) Specialization Set allows up to:

- *Ten (10) out-of-the-box types to be specialized*
- *Ten (10) specialized subtypes*
- *Twenty (20) specialized extensions*
- *Ten (10) specialized attribute groups*

To be able to use a first Specialization Set available for a given Platform, Customer must (i) order a minimum of one (1) Enterprise IP Specialization Manager (6NP-DBS-OP, 6NP-DBS-GP) Online Service and (ii) at any time, be current with the payment related to the rights to use the required numbers of Enterprise IP Specialization Usage (6NP-PGS-OP, 6NP-PGS-GP, 6KP-PGS-OP, 6KP-PGS-GP) Online Services. Moreover, in such Platform, forty (40) specialized attributes per object are allowed; the set of specialized attributes is the result of specialized subtypes, extensions and attribute groups.

The required number of Enterprise IP Specialization Usage (6NP-PGS-OP, 6NP-PGS-GP) Online Services ordered under the Named User Based licensing scheme is the sum of 3DS Offerings ordered under the Named User Based licensing scheme for a given Platform among the 3DS Offerings listed above in Table 01.

The required number of Enterprise IP Specialization Usage (6KP-PGS-OP, 6KP-PGS-GP) Online Services ordered under the Casual Named User Based licensing scheme is the number of Collaborative Business & Industry Innovator (6KB-PCS-K-OP, 6KB-PCS-K-GP) 3DS Offerings ordered under the Casual Named User Based licensing scheme for a given Platform.

Additional Enterprise IP Specialization Manager (6NP-DBS-OP, 6NP-DBS-GP) Online Services or Enterprise IP Specialization Usage (6NP-PGS-OP, 6NP-PGS-GP, 6KP-PGS-OP, 6KP-PGS-GP) Online Services for a given Platform do not grant ability to manage more than one (1) Specialization Set.

For the management of additional Specialization Sets, Customer must order the required number of Enterprise IP Specialization Capacity (6MP-PGT-OP, 6MP-PGT-GP) Online Services to address Platform specialization beyond the first Specialization Set.

At any given time, Customer cannot have, for a given Platform, more than four (4) Enterprise IP Specialization Capacity (6MP-PGT-OP, 6MP-PGT-GP) Online Services

SOLIDWORKS - 3DEXPERIENCE 3D Design business category

The following provisions supersede those of the corresponding section of the Offering Specific Terms for 3DEXPERIENCE R2026x Online Services:

For each Online Service listed below in Table 17, Customer is delivered a quantity of 3D publication credits.

3D publication credits allow Users to compute renderings or glTFs. Consumption of 3D publication credits for renderings is based on selected resolution and quality, and directly displayed in the related applications.

For the avoidance of doubt, 3D publication credits are common to the 3DEXCITE - 3DEXPERIENCE Marketing/Sales business category and the SOLIDWORKS - 3DEXPERIENCE 3D Design business category.

Moreover, any Online Service listed above in Table 17 allows Customer to deploy experience media and gives the right to access and use part of the 3DS Offerings to Guest-Users, for the only purpose of playing an experience media with the experience player, and subject to all terms and conditions of the Agreement.

An experience player is a WebGL-based player that is provided by 3DS to be integrated into Customer websites and can play experience media. An experience media is a compiled interactive 3D web experience that is published from the use of the 3DS Offerings and that can be played with the experience player. The content can vary from experience to experience. Consumption rules of 3D publication credits for playing interactive web experiences on Customer websites are specified in the Documentation.

3DS reserves the right to remove public access to any experience media, that would be reported as inappropriate or offensive by an end user.

3. OTHER PERMITTED USES FOR 3DS OFFERINGS

CROSS-PLATFORM COLLABORATION

The following provisions supersede those of the corresponding section of the Offering Specific Terms for 3DEXPERIENCE R2026x Online Services:

Cross-platform collaboration (also called cross-company collaboration) is only applicable to Online Services under the Named User Based licensing scheme.

For a given Online Service that is (i) neither Extended Enterprise User nor Remote Access in the Product Portfolio or (ii) specified as eligible for cross-platform collaboration in the applicable Documentation, a user authorized to use such Online Service on a platform can be invited by Customer to use some Licensed Programs included in such Online Service (excluding any other related services such as but not limited to the online disk space) on any Customer's Platform(s).

To invite one (1) user on a Platform, Customer may be required to be current with the payment related to the rights to use (i) one (1) Cross Platform Collaboration (6MP-CRP-OP, 6MP-CRP-GP) as specified in the Documentation, and, (ii) a minimum of one (1) equivalent Online Service on such Platform, in case a used Licensed Programs is included in a Online Service listed as required to be deployed in the applicable Documentation.

For the avoidance of doubt, it is expressly specified that an Extended Enterprise User of another Customer cannot be invited by Customer.
