LICENSED PROGRAMS

1. OPEN SOURCE SOFTWARE

The Licensed Programs may include open source software components. Whenever notices (such as acknowledgment, copies of licenses or attribution notice) are required by the original licensor, such notices are included in the Documentation of the Licensed Programs.

Moreover, some components may not be distributed and licensed under the terms of the Agreement but under the terms of their original licenses as set forth in the Documentation of the Licensed Programs themselves. Source code for these components is available upon request.

Except for components mentioned in the section "EXCLUSIONS" below, the warranty, indemnification and Support Services provided by DS under the Agreement apply to all such open source software components and shall be provided by DS and not by the original licensor, but only for the use of the Licensed Programs that is in compliance with the terms of the Agreement, and in conjunction with the Licensed Programs. The original licensors of said open source software components provide them on an "as is" basis and without any liability whatsoever to Customer (or Licensee).

2. ADDITIONAL THIRD PARTY SOFTWARE TERMS

The following terms apply in addition to the Agreement:

Oracle

The following terms also apply if Licensee is granted licenses of Oracle software:

1. The Oracle software licenses shall be used only in conjunction with the Licensed Programs.
2. Licensee shall not publish the results of any benchmark tests run on the Oracle software.
3. Oracle is a third party beneficiary of the Agreement.
4. The parties agree to exclude the Agreement from the applicability of the Uniform Computer Information Transactions Act.
5. Some Oracle software may include source code that Oracle may provide as part of its standard shipment of Oracle software and such source code shall be governed by the Oracle agreement.
6. Licensee shall not assign the licenses of the Oracle software or the Oracle agreement insofar as it relates to the Oracle software or rent or lease the Oracle software.

The ENOVIA SmarTeam Licensed Program contains a database engine software component (the "Oracle Component") used under license from Oracle Software Systems Israel. In addition to the terms set forth above regarding Oracle Software, the following terms apply if Licensee is granted licenses to Oracle Component in conjunction with ENOVIA SmarTeam Licensed Program:

1. Licensee acknowledges that the Oracle Component is not specifically developed or sublicensed for use in any nuclear, mass transit, aviation or medical application or in any other inherently dangerous applications.
2. Licensees further acknowledge, that Oracle shall not be liable for any claims or damages arising from such use if they use it for such applications, and to indemnify and hold Oracle and/or DS and any of their officers, directors and employees harmless from any claims for losses, costs, damages or liability arising out of or in connection with the use of the Oracle Component in such applications.
3. Licensee shall not transfer or duplicate the Oracle Components licensed with the ENOVIA SmarTeam Licensed Programs except for temporary transfer in the event of computer malfunctions and a single backup or archival copy.

Support for Oracle Software

Licensee may not contact Oracle for support for Oracle software licensed through DS. Licensee may not contact DS for support for Oracle software not licensed through DS.
