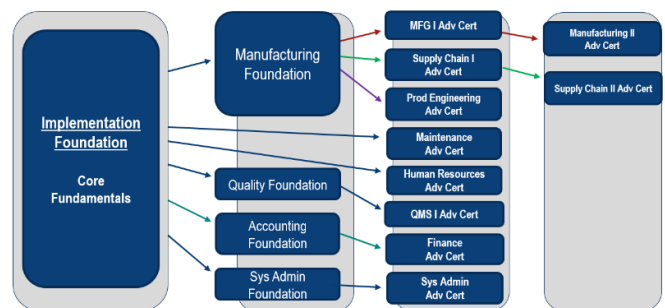

Certification Topic Summaries

FOUNDATION

Implementation

This learning path introduces new users to EIQ functionality as it pertains to implementation project tasks including system overview, inventory, production, shipping, customer service and accounting.



Manufacturing

This learning path provides users with training in regards to manufacturing processes within DELMIAWorks including setup, inventory management, production, ASSY manufacturing, material management, shipping & returns.



Quality

This learning path trains users on quality system basics including configuration and execution of workflows, module setup requirements, parameters and inter-modular relationships for QMS modules.



Accounting

This learning path covers accounting functions within EIQ including AR/AP Invoicing, Cash Receipts and Disbursements, tax codes, month end procedures and sales person/commission configuration.



System Admin

This learning path provides IT training on various applications including IQAlert, IQStatus, IQTrace, Security Inspector, Data Dictionary and basic troubleshooting.



ADVANCED

Manufacturing I

This learning path introduces user's complex ASSY lines, material tracking, projections and maintenance, label configuration and maintenance, WMS Profile setup, WMS transactions and ShopData functionality.



Manufacturing II

This learning path delves into RealTime Process functionality including RT Charts, SIC (serialized inventory control), RT Station and RT Process Monitor.



Supply Chain I

This learning path provides training on product labeling, inventory transaction tracking with WMS, material staging and hard allocation of materials to work orders.



Maintenance

This learning path trains users on the MRO module including equipment setup, equipment task setup and functionality, how to process MRO work orders and plant floor layout.



System Admin

This learning path trains DBA users on database structure, Dataload tools, user migration and various applications including IQPurge, IQExtension and Label Designer.



Finance

This learning path focuses on additional finance applications such as Avelera tax tool, multi-currency, fixed assets, ePlant configuration and import tools.



Production Engineer
